The Righteousness of God is Available!

3:21-31

Righteousness means a right relationship with God.

Righteousness comes from God, and it is apart from keeping God's commands.

This is not a new plan of righteousness but has now been revealed with the coming of Jesus Christ.

God's righteousness is for all people, but it is activated for those who believe in Jesus.

We all need God's righteousness because we are incapable of meeting God's righteous standard on our own merit.

All who believe in Jesus are justified - declared right with God - as a free gift of God's grace through Christ Jesus.

Justification is a free gift for believers, but it is costly for God as His Son bled and died to pay the penalty of our sin.

The perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ demonstrated God's righteous judgment on all sin.

God is one God and declares righteous all people who believe in Jesus Christ.

An Illustration of the Righteousness of God

4:1-25

Believing God was counted to Abraham as righteousness.

It is faith, not works, which puts Christ's righteousness in our account.

Neither outward signs nor religious activity play a part in God declaring us righteous.

Abraham believed God's Word, his faith was unwavering in hopeless circumstances, and he was fully convinced God was able to keep His promise.

We who believe in Jesus for our justification will also be declared righteous by God.

ROMANS 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, “The righteous shall live by faith.”
