PRAYER FOR HIMSELF

17:1-5

In praying for Himself, Jesus was also praying for us because His mission was to secure our salvation.

Jesus prayed to be glorified, knowing that through His suffering, God's glory would be revealed.

Our eternal life starts the moment we place our faith in the redemptive work of Christ Jesus.

To "know" God the Father and God the Son implies a continuous, personal relationship with them.

Live with one defining _____: to glorify God in everything you think, say, and do.

PRAYER FOR HIS DISCIPLES

17:6-19

Jesus praised His disciples for their dedication to His ministry and obedience to God's word.

Through the truth He revealed, Jesus sought to set apart and prepare His disciples for God's purposes.

Jesus' devotion to God's redemptive plan established the foundation His disciples would build on.

PRAYER FOR ALL BELIEVERS

17:20-26

Just hours before He died on the cross, Jesus prayed for those whose sin put Him there.

God the Father accomplishes His work through God the Son, and the Son lives to glorify His Father.

Jesus prayed for unity within the body of Christ, knowing it would ultimately glorify God the Father.

Glorify God by pursuing _____ with fellow believers as you do the work He has given you.

JOHN 3:36

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

JOHN 6:47

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.

2 TIMOTHY 2:21

Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from what is dishonorable, he will be a vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy, useful to the master of the house, ready for every good work.

MATTHEW 28:19-20
