Follow His Ways

1 Kings 1:32-2:12

Solomon Anointed King

1:32-40

- David summons the strength to crown God's choice for Israel's next king.
- Zadok, Nathan, and Benaiah, courageous men loyal to both God and David, consecrate Solomon as king instead of Adonijah.
- All of Israel rejoices and joyfully affirms God's provision of Solomon as their new king.

Adonijah's Uprising Ends

1:41-53

- What could have been a divisive war between brothers dissolves peacefully.
- God's promise to establish Solomon's throne in peace is on display as Adonijah and his supporters flee.
- Solomon would allow Adonijah to live if he would remain at his own home and show loyal support to his brother's throne.

David's Final Charges

2:1-12

- David urges Solomon to establish his reign with holy obedience through:
 - Courageous conviction and actions.
 - Respect and obedience to God's law.
 - Knowledge that God will bless both Solomon and Israel when His ways are followed.
- David urges Solomon to establish his reign with justice and personal wisdom through:
 - Punishing Joab and Shimei for violence and disloyalty.
 - Caring for Barzillai in recognition of his loyalty.
- David dies after leading Israel for 40 years and Solomon's full rule begins.
