Live out your faith as good citizens of God's kingdom.

Practice obedience! Willingly submit to those in authority in your community.

Watch your words! Avoid slandering others and engaging in quarrels.

Remember your past! Give grace to others, remembering you were once a disobedient slave to sin.

Be ready to be an ______ for good in your community, modeling Jesus in your actions and speech.

Live out your faith through good works.

God's salvation brings cleansing from sin, the gift of the Holy Spirit, and the hope of eternal life as God's heirs. Sacrificial service and good works are a testimony of receiving God's merciful gift of salvation.

Genuine Christian behavior benefits everyone.

Be ready to give ______to the lost world that you belong to God by your sacrificial service.

Live out your faith avoiding foolish controversy and divisiveness. 3:9-11

False teachers and worthless controversies should be avoided as unprofitable.

Advocates for false teaching should be warned twice concerning their behavior.

Protect the church by cutting off contact with those who refuse to repent from promoting falsehood.

Be ready to run from those who promote controversy and worthless quarrels in the church.

Live out your faith in community with fellow laborers. 3:12-15

Regardless of his circumstances, Paul surrounds himself with fellow believers.

Good works include taking care of those who are part of your faith community.

Encourage others to live productive lives so they may practice good works as well.

Be ready to reach out to other believers with love and concern, providing for their needs and prompting them to live faithfully.

Romans 13:1-2
