12:20-36

- After a long season of “not yet,” Jesus declares that the hour has _____ come.
- The uniqueness and glory of Jesus, as well as the Father’s glory, are put on full display in the crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension.
- Redemption is no longer just promised; it is soon to be accomplished.

FOR REDEMPTION'S COST AND ACCOMPLISHMENT

- Redemption required the death of the perfect Son, who satisfied the wrath of God in our place. No sacrifice has ever been more painful, costly, or _____.
